

Organic Law of the Federal Public Administration

Article 26

For the dispatch of administrative matters, the Executive Power of the Union shall have the following agencies: Ministry of the Interior; Ministry of Foreign Affairs; Ministry of National Defense; Ministry of the Navy; Ministry of Security and Citizen Protection; Ministry of Finance and Public Credit; Ministry of Welfare; Ministry of Environment and Natural Resources; Ministry of Energy; Ministry of Economy; Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development; Ministry of Infrastructure, Communications and Transportation; Ministry of Public Function; Ministry of Public Education; Ministry of Health; Ministry of Labor and Social Welfare; Ministry of Agrarian, Territorial and Urban Development; Ministry of Culture; Ministry of Tourism, and Legal Counsel of the Federal Executive.

Article 28. Section I

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs is responsible for the following matters:

I. To promote, propitiate and ensure the coordination of actions abroad of the agencies and entities of the Federal Public Administration; and without affecting the exercise of the attributions that correspond to each one of them, to conduct foreign policy, for which purpose it shall intervene in all kinds of treaties, agreements and conventions to which the country is a party;

Article 41 Bis. Sections I, II, III, XVII and XXVII

The Ministry of Culture is responsible for the following matters:

I. To develop and conduct the national policy on culture with the participation corresponding to other agencies and entities of the Federal Public Administration, as well as federal entities, municipalities and the cultural community;

II. To conserve, protect and maintain the archaeological, historical and artistic monuments that make up the cultural heritage of the Nation;

III. To formulate and implement the National Culture Program, in accordance with the applicable legal provisions;

XVII. To exercise all the attributions that the General Law of National Assets and the Federal Law on Archaeological, Artistic and Historical Monuments establish with regard to archaeological, artistic and historical monuments, as well as with respect to the zones of archaeological, artistic and historical monuments;

XXVII. Others expressly established by the laws and regulations;
